



TECHNOVATOR WINS CONTRACT TO PROVIDE INTEGRATED BUILDING SOLUTIONS SERVICES FOR ASEAN SUMMIT IN MYANMAR

(10 September 2012, Hong Kong) - Technovator International Limited (“Technovator” or “the Group”, HKEx: 1206), a leading provider of building energy management and intelligent building solutions services, is pleased to announce that it has secured a contract to provide integrated building solutions services for the Ruby Hall National Guest House (“Ruby Hall Project” or “the Project”), the venue for the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (“ASEAN”) Summit in 2014.

Technovator’s services for the Ruby Hall Project encompass the engineering, supply, installation, testing and commissioning of an Integrated Building Automation System (IBAS). The Project has commenced construction and is expected to be completed by the end of 2013.

Ruby Hall National Guest House is a convention and exhibition center in Myanmar’s capital of Nay Pyi Taw, the third largest city after Yangon and Mandalay. It has been designated as the venue for the ASEAN Summit in 2014, where Myanmar will chair the regional bloc for the first time in the country’s history. As a tradition, the Heads of State or Government of ASEAN Member States including Myanmar, Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Viet Nam will hold substantive discussions during the summit to promote further growth among the Member States.

The Group is leveraging its leading IBAS technology to interface with all the mechanical and electrical equipment in the Ruby Hall National Guest House. The system to be built by Technovator comprises 7 air-cooled chillers, 85 air handling units, electrical systems, lighting systems, plumbing systems and ventilation and smoke extraction systems, etc. The Group’s advanced IBAS technology ensures that the 4 levels of conference rooms, guest houses, and administrative rooms are at their highest energy efficiency, as well as provide the most comfortable environment for visitors and the most reliable safety equipment in the event of an emergency.

The Ruby Hall Project is Technovator's second project in Myanmar. The Group's first project in Yangon, Junction Square, is a large-scale shopping center with 300,000 square feet of retail space built on 9 acres, which opened in March 2012. The project at Junction Square deployed over 1,000 control points, enabling all interior lighting to be controlled cost-effectively. With a range of sensors including temperature, humidity, smoke, static pressure and water level integrated into the system, overall level of energy efficiency can be optimized. What is more, an energy consumption metering system consisting of 332 power meters was deployed to measure power consumption by each of the 300 tenanted shops, allowing for automated monthly billings. This system thus represents the first of its kind installed in Myanmar where tenants are billed for the actual amount of energy consumed.

Mr. Zhao Xiaobo, Executive Director and Chief Executive Officer of Technovator said, "After the successful Junction Square project in Yangon, we are delighted to secure the Ruby Hall Project, our second project in Myanmar. Winning this landmark project represents a major milestone for Technovator and strengthens a foundation for our further development in the country. Myanmar is important to us as the country is presently undergoing significant change and many projects are being planned across the country. As a first mover in the market, Technovator is in discussion with developers and the government involving large-scale projects. It is certainly worth noting as well that the Ruby Hall Project creates opportunities for us to increase our global exposure, especially among Member States of ASEAN. We will place utmost effort towards enhancing recognition of the Technovator brand internationally, thereby bringing greater returns to our shareholders."
